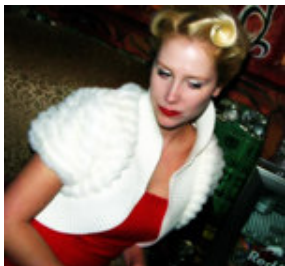
**Paul Sanchez
